Shane did say they don't build engines or transmission, but do fit what the vehicle owners supply. It was a most impressive and super clean workshop.

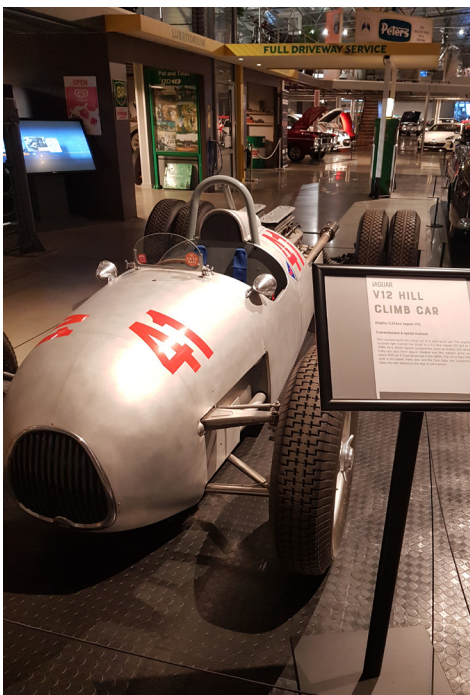

Level 1 event postponed

We have been forced to postpone our Level 1 Rallysprint, scheduled for May 11.

The entry-level event was set to be run in the Whroo Forest near Rushworth in the state's goldfields, however a planned control burn by forestry means a permit on that date will not be issued.

A Level 1 Rallysprint is designed to introduce new competitors to rallying. Cars are not required to have roll cages, front head restraint are not mandatory, and events must have a maximum average speed of no more than 70km/h.

Event director, Chris Aggenbach, said that the club will endeavour to secure a new date for the event, likely to be August 3.

North Eastern Rallysprint

The North Eastern Rallysprint, set for July 20, is an all-new event but harks back to various events held in a similar format two decades ago.

Set in the Moyhu Forest on flowing, undulating roads, a single 10-kilometre stage will be run multiple times in both directions throughout the course of the day.

An optional reconnaissance run will be conducted for the stages before the competition begins at a leisurely time beyond 9:30am from the Moyhu Recreation Reserve.

Promoted by the North Eastern Car club, the North Eastern Rallysprint will be capped at 30 cars, with Supplementary Regulations available in a matter of weeks.
